ILLI's Supported Living includes a variety of person-centered approaches designed to help adults receiving supports to live meaningful, contributing lives.

Personal outcomes often include:

- A home that reflects personal taste and lifestyles.
 - Interesting and meaningful daytime activities (ex.: work, volunteering, organizational memberships).
 - Safe guards that include attention to health and safety.
 - 24 hour availability of an call direct support and management staff.
 - Relationships and friendships with others who share interest and talents.
 - Involvement of persons supported in interviewing selecting, training, scheduling, managing, and dismissing of staff.
 - Participation in ILLI staff development and policy review.
 - Freely made informed choices.
